There will be links sent in the Weekly Sync and listed on the <u>MBC Teens</u> <u>page</u> for each event so please sign up for the ones you wish to attend.

Secondly, we are aware that we all have different comfort levels around people and wearing masks. We as a church want to abide by the guidelines the state has laid out for us. That means wearing a mask when social distancing cannot be met outside. We have purposefully chosen events where we can be outside and still have social distancing measures in place so we can be mask free, but we acknowledge that this is difficult to always maintain, especially during pickup and drop off times. **We ask that you please come to each event with a mask and if needed wear one when social distancing cannot be met. If there is a persistent issue taking place of this not taking place, we will ask the student to be picked up from the event early.**

Lastly, as for transportation in church vehicles, masks will need to be worn throughout the duration of the ride. Please wear your mask before entering the van. You may remove it once you have exited the vehicle.

We appreciate your grace and understanding during these times. For us to be able to meet in person is such a joy and blessing for us all. We just want to make sure we are running these events safely, smoothly and that all of our students are aware of what to expect when they attend.
