- 1. Read Malachi 3:1 and 4:5-6 & compare to Luke 1:17. What was to be the ministry of the forerunner as foretold in the O.T.? Who is the forerunner?
- 2. The Greek name "Jesus" was the counterpart of the Hebrew name "Joshua". In what way would Jesus' ministry be similar to that of Joshua (Matthew 1:21; Joshua 1:11-13)? What according to Matthew 1:21-23, would be the nature of the one named Jesus?
- 3. In Mary's hymn of praise, she acknowledged that the birth of Jesus would be the fulfillment of God's promise concerning Abraham. What promise is this (Genesis 12:1-3; 13:14-17; 15:1-6, 18; 17:4-8)?
