Text: Isaiah 9:1-7

- Share about a time when you experienced a season of “darkness.” How did God’s light break through?
- Read Isaiah 9:1–2. What do you notice about the contrast between gloom and glory?
- According to Isaiah 8:21–22, what led God’s people into “thick darkness”? How do you see similar patterns today?
- In verses 3–5, what are the results of God’s light breaking in? How do joy, freedom, and peace connect to the gospel?
- Look at verse 6. Which of the four titles of Christ (Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace) speaks to you most right now? Why?
- Verse 7 promises a reign of endless peace and justice. How does this future hope give us strength to live faithfully in today’s cultural darkness?
- On the topic of justice and righteousness, what were your biggest takeaways from the interview with Krista and Monique?
- What “darkness” are you tempted to walk in today? How can you choose the light of Christ instead?
- How can our group encourage one another to shine Christ’s light in our community this week?
