**Text:** Psalm 8

1. Why do you think that the Psalmist begins and ends focusing on the majesty of God?
2. Think of a time where you were taken back by God’s creation (beach, mountain, canyon. What went through your mind and how does that relate to God’s infinite nature?
3. In what ways does the reality that God sees us and remembers us help us to navigate the challenges and trials of life?
4. Where do we as Christians ground our identity and our corresponding dignity? Is it in the things we do or in what God says about us?
5. What are some ways that we reflect God as humans that distinguish us from the rest of creation?
6. What does it mean practically for you to live out the rule and dominion as referenced in verses 6-8? How are you to reflect God in your family, church, and vocation?
7. 7. Taking dominion at first might seem to lord our superiority over creation, but how does this Psalm show dominion to be best seen as stewarding God’s creation?
8. 8. Take a moment to read Psalm 8 as a prayer to God and how all of life is to be in service to our great God.
